

<p>National Campaign on <i>Tinospora cordifolia</i></p> <p>PROPAGATION AND CULTIVATION</p> <p>The plant is easily propagated by stem cuttings. It is perfectly suited and grows well in almost any type of soil and under varying climatic conditions. It is specially trained to grow on Neem tree, thereby it is supposed to possess more medicinal virtue. It can also be grown by sowing seeds in monsoon, but the growth of seedling is very slow as compared to plants grown by cuttings.</p> <p>AGRO-TECHNIQUES</p> <p>The stem cuttings are sown directly in the field. Cutting are obtained from older stem with nodes. Cuttings should be sown within 24 hours of their removal from the mother plant. Meanwhile, they should be half-dipped in water vertically.</p> <p>PROPAGATE RATE AND TREATMENT</p> <p>About 2500 cuttings are required for plantation in 1 hectare of land. 


